

Curriculum Vitae: MARCELLO SPAGNULO



Marcello Spagnulo was born in Rome, Italy, in 1960.

He graduated in Aeronautical Engineering, at the Rome University "La Sapienza".

In 1987 he began his professional career at Italspazio Consortium in Rome as Space Mission Specialist.

From 1988 he worked at the European Space Agency ESA ESTEC establishment in Noordwijk, Netherlands, as Space Mission Engineer.

From 1990 he worked in Arianespace, Evry, France as Ariane 4 Launch Vehicle Mission Specialist, attending 14 launch campaigns in Kourou launch base in French Guyana.

From 1997 he worked in former Alenia Spazio (today Thales Alenia Space SpA), in Rome, acting in various management responsibilities in the Sales & Programme Directorate, the Marketing Directorate and the Corporate & Strategy Directorate.

From 2005 he was employed in Finmeccanica in the Space Activities Directorate as Director Assistant.

From 2009 he is employed at the Italian Space Agency ASI, in Rome, as staff within the ASI President Office.

From 2006 to 2009 he has been Member of the Board of Directors of the NGL Prime SpA company, formed in 2006 by Finmeccanica and EADS Astrium, a company focused in space transportation R&D.

He is author of more than 40 published technical papers; in 2009 he has published with a primary publishing editor a commercial book "Lo Spazio oltre la Terra" related to space exploration.

He gives lectures and seminars at the Masters in "La Sapienza" University and in "Tor Vergata" University, both located in Rome. He has provided in 2006 lessons at the "Istituto Superiore delle Telecomunicazioni" of the Italian Minister of Communications.

In 2005 he has been awarded with a Master from the Italian Minister of Defence "Centro Alti Studi Difesa", after attending the 56° course of the "Istituto Alti Studi della Difesa" of the MoD.

He has attended several courses on Management and Economics at IRI Management School in Rome and at the SDA Management School of the Bocconi University in Milan.
